Nastro Azzurro (Blue Ribbon) is an established brand in the UK, having been imported since 1965. This premium beer is brewed using the finest two-row spring planted malting barley		

Beck's, Brauerei Beck, Germany 5.0% abv	£3.00	275ml
Light coloured with a crisp refreshing taste full of character. Brewed in Bremen according to the German Purity Law which allows only natural ingredients of barley, hops, yeast and water in the brewing process		

Budvar, Budejovicky Budvar, £3.00 330ml
Czech Republic 5.0% abv
Brewed with Žatec hops and Moravian barley, Budvar is lagered (cold conditioned) for three months to produce its unique character. This is one of the longest maturation periods for light beers

Bonsecours Framboise, Brasserie Caulier, £3.95 330ml
Belgium 7.0% abv
Pale brown with flavours of hops and a dry raspberry finish. Unfiltered, unpasteurised and made with local spring water

Chimay Red, Chimay Trappist Monastery, £3.95 330ml
Belgium 7.0% abv
This is slightly sweet with caramel and honey flavours. The more the drink warms, the more the flavours and aromas become apparent

Alcohol-free Beck's, Brauerei Beck, £3.00 275ml
Germany 0.05% abv
Brewed using the same method as the regular Beck's but then de-alcoholised at the end of the process to retain the same taste

British Beers & Cider

Landlord Strong Pale Ale, Timothy Taylor, £3.85 500ml
Yorkshire 4.1% abv
Deep golden with a ruby sheen and fresh aromas of citrus fruit. Richly textured with a bitter spectrum of flavours and a biscuity, malty finish

Organic Best Bitter, St Peter's, £3.85 500ml
Suffolk 4.1% abv
Soil Association accredited and made from organically grown Chariot malted barley. The addition of organically grown Golding hops provides the distinctive fully hopped character. The result is a full-bodied best bitter with a refreshing aftertaste

Champion Live Beer, Wells & Young's, £3.85 500ml
Bedfordshire 5.0% abv
Refreshing and not overpowering, Champion is matured in the bottle to provide well rounded floral and citrus flavours with hints of fruit and a dry, hoppy bitterness. Young's Champion is a light golden, full flavoured English beer with the sparkling bite of a continental lager

India Pale Ale, Meantime Brewery, £8.75 750ml
London 7.5% abv
Light copper in colour with an inviting aroma from Fuggle and Goldings hops. Full of tart citrus fruit, ginger and marmalade notes overlaid with rich marzipan. 'India style' ales are characterised by pale malts, long maturation, massive hopping levels and high alcoholic strength

Organic Honey Dew, Fuller's, £3.85 500ml
London 5.0% abv
A golden beer brewed entirely from English organic malt with hops and laced with the finest organic honey. Wonderfully aromatic on the nose and outstandingly smooth. The natural sweetness is perfectly counterbalanced by Target hops giving a zesty finish

Organic Best Ale, Sam Smiths, £3.35 355ml
Yorkshire 5.0% abv
From a fiercely independent brewer, this is a delicate golden ale with a background of hops and malt. Hints of treacle and spice on the nose, warming and crisp

1859 Porter, Harvey's, East Sussex 4.8% abv £3.35 275ml
Brewed according to Henry Harvey's recipe of 1859 and using local hops and spring water. Aromas of hops and cedar, dry with a bitter chocolate finish

The Bitter, Adnams, Suffolk 4.5% abv £3.85 500ml
Nicely hopped with English hops for fragrance and a refreshing, bitter aftertaste

Curious Brew Lager, Chapel Down, Kent 5.0% abv £3.00 330ml
A secondary fermentation using sparkling wine yeast gives body and complex aromas. On the finish there is depth of flavour and a nutty dryness

Banana Bread, Wells & Young's, Bedfordshire 5.2% abv £3.85 568ml
Brewed using Fairtrade bananas, the finest English Challenger and Goldings hops sampled by hand. This attention to detail guarantees a consistently delicious creamy flavour which is both tropical and dry

Hen's Tooth, Greene King, Suffolk 6.5% abv £3.85 500ml
Previously brewed at the Morland brewery. Strong but surprisingly crisp with an aromatic, bittersweet finish, active yeast in the bottle helps the beer to mature and give a draught-like complexity

Double Chocolate Stout, Wells & Young's, Bedfordshire 5.2% abv £3.85 500ml
Young's Double Chocolate Stout has it all, delivering a satisfying, indulgent taste without ever becoming overly sweet. Chocolate malt and real dark chocolate are combined with Young's award-winning, full-flavoured dark beer

Special London Ale, Wells & Young's, Bedfordshire 6.4% abv £3.85 500ml
A winner of many awards. Despite its strength it is sublimely drinkable. Malty richness is countered by heavy hopping to create a balanced, aromatic, dry and fruity flavour

London Porter, Meantime Brewery, London 6.5% abv £8.75 750ml
Brewed from a recipe created in 1750 using seven malts. Demand for this beer made London the brewing capital of the world. Full of earthy, roasted malt aromas and a sweetish caramel on the palate giving way to a smoky, dry maltiness

Oak-Aged Beer, Innis & Gunn, Scotland 6.6% abv £3.35 330ml
Aged in brand new malt whisky barrels made from American oak. Intense aromas of fresh, grassy hops and a deep, almost briny note. The oak is noticeable as luscious hints of vanilla and caramel. The freshness of the hops cuts through this sweetness and the acidity is clean in the finish

Bulmers Original Cider, Herefordshire 4.5% abv £3.85 568ml
Brewed with English apples and chill-filtered at zero degrees to give a pure, crisp, refreshing flavour and natural character

Premier Cru Cyder, Aspall, Suffolk 7.0% abv £3.85 500ml
Pale gold with hints of green and a delicate sparkle. The finish is long and dry with bright flavours of green apple
